

Still time to register for the 2011 EWRI Workshop

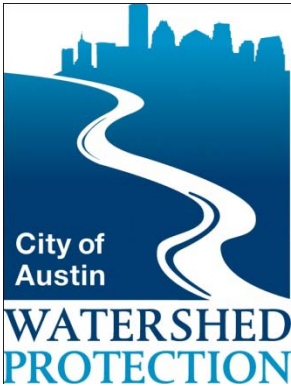
Sustainable Stormwater Management and Adverse Impact Mitigation
