1. Eligibility

Applicants must fulfill the following criteria in order to be considered for a scholarship:

- University of Texas at Austin student registered for the Spring 2017 semester.
- Civil Engineering Major currently classified as a sophomore, junior, or senior. Seniors graduating in the spring of 2017 are eligible.
- Membership and active participation in the ASCE Student Chapter at the University of Texas at Austin.

2. Evaluation Criteria

Merit of the applicant will be evaluated using the following selection criteria:

- Transcript / GPA
- ASCE Participation
- Other Extracurricular Activities
- Financial Need
- Quality of Written Statement

3. Scholarship Application Checklist

Applicants will be responsible for providing the following:

- Completed and signed four (4) page application form.
- A written statement, up to one (1) page in length, 12 pt. font, discussing why you decided to become a Civil Engineer and how ASCE has enriched your life. Please take this as an opportunity to share any additional information that you would like for us to know about you.

4. Submission Information and Deadlines

Applications must be received by 12:00 pm (noon) on Friday, March 3, 2017. Please submit your completed and signed application form and written statement to the Engineering Scholarship Program, ESS 120.
